APPENDIX

This appendix to the September 2023 Black British Voices Project Report provides the dataset from our national survey, which received over 10,000 responses.

Our intention in publishing this dataset is to facilitate a serious national conversation about anti-Black racism, why it is still so embedded and persistent, and why more is not being done to challenge and eradicate it. Putting this information into the hands of the public means that everyone can take part in this conversation – driven by the experiences and insights from Black communities across the UK.

We hope you will join us in using the data from this report to drive forward the much-needed awareness of why — in every sector of public, private, political and professional life — the historic burden of racial injustice must be lifted. We need to state clearly that intolerance has no place in a modern, inclusive and progressive society. This is a message we all need to be focused on until it is no longer a message that is needed. Until then, we need the voices in this project to be joined by as many others as possible, so that the message that intolerance is not acceptable becomes effective action and not just words.

ABOUT THE SURVEY

This survey took place over five months, from May to November 2021, in which time we received responses from over 10,000 Black people living in the UK.

The survey questions were hosted in Qualtrics, a software licensed by the University of Cambridge. There were 80 questions in total, with an average response time of 67 minutes and an average completion rate of 78.5%. Notably, we saw an overwhelming consensus in several areas - in some cases as many as 8000 voices spoke as one (see Q27).

ABOUT THE RESPONDENTS

There were two key requirements for participation in the BBVP survey. The first was that participants were required to confirm they were over 16 years of age, to meet ethical and safeguarding guidelines. The second was that all participants self-identified as being Black and a UK resident.

This survey dataset is available under an attribution, non-commercial, no derivatives creative commons license (<u>CC BY-NC-ND 4.0</u>).



Due to the arrangement of questions in the survey software, some question numbers are skipped in this report, but none of the questions themselves are missing.














Q13 - Are you proud to be British?














Q22 - Is acceptance of the Black LGBTQ+ community better or worse compared to 10 years ago?




Q24 - Generally speaking, do you think Black LBGTQ+ people face more discrimination than black heterosexuals?


















Q34 - Does your religion/faith play a significant role in your everyday life?






















